Jon Waters, filmmaker and author, said, "Read. Keep a five day work week. And if you write in the morning, don't drink too much the night before."

Amanda Foreman, author and former National Book Awards judge, said, "Don't give up your day job. And I really advocate doing some kind of journalism first. Ernest Hemingway said that every writer should do a stint at journalism but not too long because it will ruin your writing, but in the beginning it will help you hone your craft."
